The Yvette Baker Trophy is Britain's premier Junior Inter-Club competition for clubs in England and Wales. It is named after Britain's first World Champion, Yvette Baker, who won Gold in the short distance in Scotland in 1999.

The winners were LOC, with 885 points, second OD with 878 and third HH with 845. DEE and Devon had 844 points each,
